TDA-Europe Festival Kicks Off in London

The Tigray Development Association (TDA) Europe Festival kicked off in London on Saturday (24th August) as Chapters of the TDA in Europe launched their reports, in the presence of a high level delegation led by H.E. Abay Weldu, President of the Tigray Regional State.
